No reports for Grant Road. PCSO ELLIOT is working with young people in the area to address drinking</p>
<p><b><i>To reduce the anti social use of motor vehicles including speeding</i></b> – Complaints have been received from residents who are reporting people using excessive speed in the Drayton and Farlington area</p>	<p>There has been preliminary interest in Community Speedwatch where members of the community are encouraged to take part in Speeding Operations. The pilot remains in the pipelines. There are a number of residents who have shown interest. PC Steve ELLIS is the lead on this and information packs will be shared with members of the community at Neighbourhood Forums</p> <p>Cllr ELLCOME updated that financial agreements have been made for physical improvements to Farlington Avenue and the final arrangements/discussions are now under way for this</p>
